PRIME SPONSORED BILL SUMMARY

SENATE BILL 179

This bill would amend the Second Class County Code (which pertains to Allegheny County alone) to provide for an increase in the income limit for the Senior Citizen Property Tax Relief program administered by the county. Specifically, the annual income limit would increase from \$30,000 to \$31,500 counting half of any social security income. Eligible applicants ages 60 and over who have resided continuously in Allegheny County for the past ten years will be granted a 30% reduction in their county property tax bill.
